

# STUDENTS ENGAGEMENT IN COMMUNITY LEARNING CENTER IN “AMA CHATASALI”

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## **Daily Activities:**

Since the textbooks of primary and upper primary students have been completed, only the subject of the students is being revised. So that the students can clear their doubts. Extracurricular activities class has been closed as the students have exams ahead.



## **Parents Meeting:**

Like every month, this month too, parents' meetings were held, various problems of the

## OBSERVATION AND CELEBRATION

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### **Shree Panchami(Saraswati Puja):**

From the religious point of view, Maa Saraswati is called as “Vidya Datri”, on Shree Panchami, the puja of Maa Saraswati Devi was organized at Amachatasali. Most of the children do not know about Saraswati Puja because they



do not go to school. To connect the children with this puja, Anweshana volunteers and children together decorate the puja mandap. Prasad is prepared. The children also get a chance to know about their culture and traditions. After the puja is over, the children return to their homes with the prasad.

### **Maha Sivaratri (Jagar):**

ANWESHANA volunteers and children lit Panchagavya lamps in Jagar in the name of Lord Shiva. The aim is to give a message of environmental protection to the society. Because during Shivaratri, due to the burning of earthen



lamps in large numbers, the amount of waste increases, but after lighting the Panchagavya lamp, this lamp does not remain as waste but gets mixed with the soil within two to three days and increases the fertility of the soil.

## **International Childhood Cancer Day (ICCD):**

International Childhood Cancer Day (ICCD) is observed every year on 15<sup>th</sup> February to raise awareness about childhood cancer and its impact on children and their families.

Creating awareness among parents is very important to ensure timely detection, diagnosis and treatment of childhood cancer. Therefore, Dr Souvna Sahoo, in collaboration with our partner institution SANYOG, sensitized parents of children studying in Amachatasali.



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
